1 DAT module

1.1 DAT types

There are 3 different types of DAT module

- SystemDAT (CY42-S1): Firmware updates (more recent firmware version) and change of language package
- FunctionDAT (CY42-F1/F2):

For firmware upgrades

- F1: for 2 current outputs
- F2: for additional functionalities (only "Advanced" firmware package)
- CopyDAT (CY42-C1): Memory for own configurations and for copying own configurations to other CM42 devices

1.2 Using the DAT



Insert the DAT module into the right-hand slot (item 1) in the housing cover.

- └ If the cover does not have a suitable opening for a DAT module (item 1), release the retaining clips (item 2) and remove the cover. Fit and secure the cover again after using the DAT module.
- 2. Select the desired function from the DAT menu.
- 3. Follow the instructions on the screen until the prompt to restart the device appears.
- **4.** If changing the hardware: connect the new hardware (other sensor type or other sensor module with the relevant cable and sensor).
- 5. Remove the DAT module from the slot.

1.3 DAT functions

1.3.1 SystemDAT

A SystemDAT is used for:

Firmware updates

Devices from May 2006 (serial number 85...) to May 2009 (serial number C5...):

- 1. Disconnect the device from the power supply.
- 2. Insert the SystemDAT.
- 3. Start the device and following the instructions on the screen.

Devices from June 2009 (serial number C6...) or after:

- 1. Insert the SystemDAT during operation.
- 2. SETUP/DAT menu/SystemDAT Open.
- 3. Select "Update" and follow the instructions on the screen.

Devices up to May 2006: DAT modules are not supported

Changing the language

- 1. SETUP/DAT menu/SystemDAT Open.
- 2. Select "Language" and follow the instructions on the screen.

1.3.2 FunctionDAT

A FunctionDAT is used to extend the functionality of your Liquiline M CM42. There are two different types of FunctionDAT:

- Upgrade from one to two current outputs
- Upgrade from the "Basic" to the "Advanced" firmware version.

1. SETUP/DAT menu/FunctionDAT Open.

2. Follow the instructions on the screen.

1.3.3 CopyDAT

A CopyDAT is used to save and load configurations.

1. SETUP/DAT menu/CopyDAT Open.

2. Follow the instructions on the screen.
